RICCIONE MODA ITALIA is a competition for young designers who will be finishing their studies. Students present their design proposal in the fashion category they prefer to.

The final stage of the competition will be celebrated between 19th and 25th July 2010 in Riccione.

Children's Fashion Europe will be actively collaborating during these days on the children's fashion section.

The awards on this category are a €1.000 and a studying-internship at the Saga International Design Centre – Copenhagen.

### 2. CFE in KOREA: visit to the KIF's FAIR.

CFE visits another South-East Asian market: now it is the turn for Seoul. With the opportunity of the celebration of the International Exhibition of children's fashion Kids in Fashion & Style, which was celebrated at the COEX of Seoul, from 20th to 22nd May 2010, CFE made its first approximation to the Korean children's fashion market.

CFE also visited EUCCK – European Chamber of Commerce in Korea – where a meeting with the representatives of the textile and fashion committee took place. A market study and a report of Kid in Fashion & Style Fair will be available for CFE members very soon.

### 3. FIMI – INFODAY.

During the celebration of the International Children's and Young People Fashion Fair in Valencia, on Saturday June 19th, CFE is organizing an INFODAY in the exhibition centre of Feria Valencia. With an estimated duration of one hour, an explanation of the most recent achievements of the European Projects that CFE is carrying out will be offered.

## 4. REPORT of LAST CEN's MEETING.

On May 25th and 26th, a meeting of the **TC/248 WG20: Safety on children's clothing** was celebrated in London. Children's Fashion Europe was attending as an observer.

During the meeting, different interesting items were discussed, regarding the revision of the existing Standard of Safety of children's clothing, but also related to Technical Reports which may allow for a better understanding of the EN14682:2007. A TR: Replies to Interpretation and a TR on General Mechanical Safety of Children's Clothing are being written.

The revision of the Standard *EN14682 Safety of children's clothing- Cords and drawstrings on children's clothing – Specifications* continues its process. Along June, a first draft of this document will be sent to the European Commission so that progress to be adopted start. Due to the process complexity, it is expected to be approved by December 2012.

With this new revision, trend changes, design and manufacturing requirements want to be included on the Standard. The main differences will be regarding the length of the drawstrings on bottom chest worn garments; the allowance of decorative cords on specific garment parts; hoods' designing characteristics.

This is a Standard, even though being normalized, will be of voluntarily adoption by the EU countries.



## 5. CFE'S FIRST CATALOGUE

CHILDREN'S FASHION EUROPE has published its first catalogue. In this edition, all its members are presented together with their brands, products and contact details.

## 6. ACTIVE PARTICIPATION AT UEAPME
